





# CHECKLIST FOR APPLYING FOR A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE ORDER (DVO)



## 1 DOCUMENTS REQUIRED



**DV01 Form:** Available on the Queensland Courts website.

### **Options for completion:**

- Online
- Interactive PDF
- Printable PDF for manual completion
- · Paper form at the local Magistrates Court



### Statutory Declaration

• Must be signed and witnessed by a Justice of the Peace.



### Supporting Documents

- Any additional documents to provide detailed descriptions of incidents.
- Evidence of domestic violence (e.g., police reports, medical records, photographs).



#### Identification Documents

- Personal identification (e.g., driver's license, passport).
- Birth certificates of children (if naming children in the application).

# 2 DETAILS TO INCLUDE IN THE APPLICATION



### Incident Descriptions

- Detailed descriptions of incidents of domestic violence.
- Specific instances of physical, emotional, or verbal abuse.
- Exact words used during threats or abusive incidents.



### Children's Information

- Names and details of any children to be included in the order.
- Information about unborn children if applicable.



### Contact Information

- Current contact details for the aggrieved.
- Details of any safe contact methods or alternative addresses.

### **3 PREPARATION STEPS**

- Step 1: Gather Necessary Information
  - Compile a timeline of domestic violence incidents.
  - Collect any relevant documents or evidence supporting your case.
- Step 2: Complete the DV01 Form
  - Fill out the form online, via PDF, or at the local Magistrates Court.
  - Ensure all sections are accurately completed.
- Step 3: Statutory Declaration
  - Arrange a meeting with a Justice of the Peace.
  - Sign the declaration in their presence.
- Step 4: Attach Additional Documents
  - Attach any extra pages or documents to the DV01 form as needed.
- Step 5: File the Application
  - Submit the completed form and supporting documents to the local Magistrates Court.

    - In-person at the Magistrates Court
